MONTEBELLO RECEIVES A NEW PARK – TAYLOR RANCH GREENSPACE PROJECT NOW COMPLETE

WHAT: The City of Montebello has completed the Taylor Ranch Greenspace Project and will host a soft reopening, attended by City Council and staff to celebrate the historic park's unveiling.

WHY: The Taylor Ranch Greenspace Project was initiated in 2018 to provide the community with a temporary but functional park, with efforts to develop a Taylor Ranch Cultural Arts Center also underway. The City is proud to announce that the park will now offer a beautiful, new green space, with a picturesque pond and gazebo feature. Members of the public will also be able to enjoy new recreational amenities including a basketball court and picnic area. Renovations include ensuring all park restrooms were updated and ADA compliant. Improvements to the parking lot, sidewalks, irrigation, and landscaping were made as well.

The City encourages members of the community to come and see the park for themselves. The park will be open for passive use only. Visitors will be required to follow safety protocols by wearing a mask and maintaining social distance.
